**Tree Well Rejuvenation Project**

Morristown is undertaking a tree well rejuvenation project in your area. Work is expected to begin on or about October 30, 2018. Work will involve the installation of a soil amendment in tree wells, as well as a porous tree well surface system to replace mulch/wood chips. Improvements will foster healthier trees, reduce maintenance, and improve walkability.

Work under this project will involve two separate contractors working in conjunction to schedule work to minimize periods of disturbance. Work in front of your establishment will be completed in approximately two days with only a few hours of disturbance each day. **NO WORK WILL BE PERFORMED ON 10/31 or 11/6.** 

- Tree Root Invigoration Project via Biochar Soil Amendment
  - > Contractor: The F.A. Bartlett Tree Expert Company
- Furnish and Install Flexipave Porous Surface in Existing Tree Wells
  - > Contractor: Waters and Bugbee, Inc.

The project will include the following work:

- 1. Removal of existing tree well mulch and tree well grates.
- 2. Air spading of existing tree well soil and installation of Biochar soil amendment.
- 3. Installation of Flexipave porous surface treatment.

What to expect during construction:

- 2. Working hours will be on Monday Friday, 8am 3:30pm with select restrictions by location.
- 3. On-street parking in and along the construction zone will be prohibited during construction, and will be reinstated outside of working hours and in all cases for evenings and weekends.
- 4. Access to all businesses will be maintained at all times.
- 5. Sidewalk areas within the work zone will remain open while work is ongoing. There may, however, be brief interruptions when the contractor is actively air-spading.
- 6. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
