Treasured Tradition: Christmas Festival at the Morristown Green

Seasonal festivities kick off with Santa's arrival on Nov. 25

It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas in Morristown, where revelers young and old are getting ready to welcome back a treasured century-old tradition.

The Christmas Festival at the Morristown Green, presented by the Morristown Partnership with support from many generous sponsors, will once again bring the magic and the wonder of the season to the town's famous Green. Decked out in holiday finery, the Morristown Green will become a wonderland of nostalgia during the month-long festival. Visits and photos with Santa, ice sculpture demonstrations, a vintage-style rocking horse and rides on a miniature train will all return to delight the children while families

bask in the glow of thousands of dazzling lights. Activities are free to visitors, with the exception of a \$10 fee for a photo with Santa.

"The Christmas Festival at the Morristown Green is something we, and the community, look forward to all year," said Karen Carvelli, director of development at the Morristown Partnership. "Santa's arrival, holiday music and seasonal decorations are just the beginning of this month-long event that brings families from near and far to enjoy the festivities," Carvelli said.

The kick off of the Christmas Festival is scheduled for Sunday, Nov. 25 from 5 to 8 p.m. beginning with the arrival of Santa followed by the always exciting traditional count down to the Lighting of the Morristown Green. The evening will also include live music as well as hot chocolate and cookies provided by long time sponsor, Hyatt Regency Morristown.

"The Christmas Festival at the Morristown Green is a magical event that brings the community together to celebrate and be thankful for all we have during the holiday season," said Ilemona Salifu, director of sales and marketing for the Hyatt Regency Morristown.

"We look forward each year to working with the Morristown Partnership to ensure an unforgettable experience for the members of our wonderful community," Salifu added.

New this year, Santa photos will be free with a current receipt from one of the following restaurants: Mega BBQ on Spring Street, or End of Elm, George & Martha's American Grille and the Grasshopper Off the Green, all three located on Morris Street. (Note: receipts must be for a minimum purchase of \$10 and within 24 hours of the Santa visit).

Among the scheduled activities, Pinot's Palette owners Chris and Emma Harvey will offer an ornament decorating craft for the third year since opening their art studio in 2016.

"We are super excited to participate again this year," Chris Harvey said. "The Christmas Festival at the Morristown Green holds a special place in our hearts since we have been taking our young son to see Santa there every year since he was born. We hope that our small contribution to the festivities in December will bring smiles to the faces of residents, visitors and our favorite repeat guests again this year."

The Fifth annual "Morristown Merry Tuba Christmas" (MMTC) concert will take place on Saturday, Dec. 22 and is shaping up to be one of the biggest yet according to Matthew Paterno and John Palatucci, board members of MMTC and co-conductors of the large-scale performance.

"We have had as many as 120 tuba and euphonium players join us in the past, and we would love to see 200 this year," Paterno said. "This is one of the largest Merry Tuba Christmas events in the tri-state area next to the Rockefeller Plaza performance in New York City," Paterno added.

Event sponsor Morristown Medical Center, part of Atlantic Health System, has supported the Christmas Festival for nearly 20 years, according to Gwen Rippey, PhD., manager of community

health for the hospital. "This holiday tradition is a favorite of our team members and we're so pleased to have Goryeb Children's Hospital hosting a holiday card making activity on Sunday, Dec. 2 from 1 to 3 p.m.," she said.

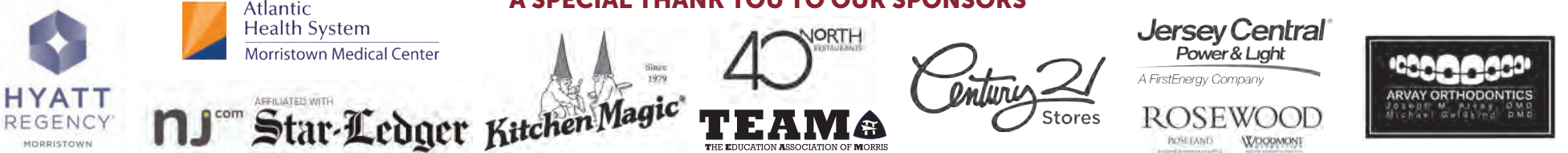

10 tips from JCP&L for safe holiday decorating

Seasonal decorations, including lights, trees and wreaths, can help put your household in the holiday spirit. However, when not used properly, decorations – particularly lights – can create safety hazards or cause fires.

Keep the family safe during the holidays. Prior to use, read the manufacturer's instructions for each item to understand how to use it properly. In addition, follow these best practices to ensure your holiday lights and decorations are installed correctly:

1. Double check lights for frayed wires or cracks, and be sure there is a bulb in each socket. Discard and replace damaged strands.
2. When decorating outside, keep ladders and decorations away from overhead power lines. Ensure the ladder is securely placed on the ground before climbing.
3. Lights should be approved by Underwriters Laboratory. "UL" will be clearly displayed on the tag, signifying the product has been inspected for potential safety hazards. Red UL



marks indicate the lights are safe for indoor/outdoor use, and green UL marks indicate the lights are only safe for indoor use.

4. Do not hammer tacks or nails into the electrical cord when hanging lights. Instead, use clips to safely attach lights to the house.
5. Use heavy-duty extension cords, and only use cords outdoors if they are designated for outdoor use. Avoid overloading extension cords by using no more than three sets of standard lights per cord.
6. If possible, outdoor lights and inflatable decorations should be plugged into circuits protected by ground fault circuit interrupters (GFCI). GFCIs help prevent electric shock by breaking the circuit when differences in the currents of hot and neutral wires occur.
7. Use a timer or turn off lights before going to bed, or if you will be away from home.
8. For special ornaments that plug into a bulb receptacle, use no more than two per strand, or check the manufacturer's directions.
9. Indoor lights should not touch drapes, furniture or carpeting. Keep lit candles away from flammable items, too.
10. Prevent tripping by placing cords and decorations in low-traffic areas where they won't be walked on. Avoid twisting, kinking or crushing cords.

Additionally, if you have children in your home, use safety caps on all electrical outlets that are not in use to prevent shock. Keep sharp objects out of reach, as well as items that could be swallowed.

By taking the proper precautions both inside and outside of your home, you can prevent hazards and focus on friends and



family during the holidays. Don't forget to periodically check lights and decorations throughout the season to ensure they continue to operate safely. **Happy holidays!**

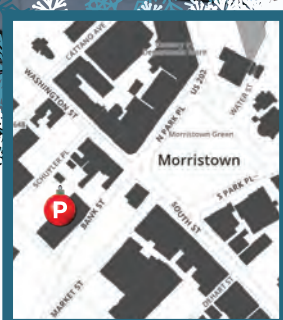
