**UPDATED REGULATIONS AND GUIDANCE
FOR OUTSIDE DINING IN MORRISTOWN
SEPTEMBER 21, 2020**

Morristown Restaurant Owners,

Expanded outdoor dining is now extended through **November 1, 2020**. Please note that curbside parklets located on State highways (ie South Street and Speedwell Avenue) remain subject to NJDOT permitting and we await their response regarding an end date.

Secondly, the extended hours for outside dining of 12 o'clock midnight on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights will remain in place for the remainder of expanded outdoor dining. We thank everyone for their continued cooperation.

Please review the attached guidance from the Morristown Fire Bureau regarding using heaters outside. It is important that every establishment follow these safety measures to ensure ongoing enjoyment of outdoor dining as the temperatures change.

As stated in the previous guidance, please be reminded of the following:

- No standing patrons will be permitted; everyone must be seated to be served
- All on-premise alcohol service must be done by wait staff to seated patrons
- Capacity for any outside dining area or expansion will be limited to no more than the indoor capacity of the associated business and will be limited by the number of seats identified in their approved outdoor dining layout.
- All outdoor dining expansions must adhere to the Sidewalk Café ordinances found at Chapter 4-5 in the Town Code.
- All outdoor dining expansions approved administratively are effective through September 7, 2020 (Labor Day)
- Any outdoor dining expansions that include on-street parking are approved for 30 days and subject to review thereafter
- Tables are not to be placed on tree wells with flexipave as the furniture may damage them
- Compliance with the Governor's executive orders and the guidance issued by the NJ Department of Health (both of which are attached to this document) is required

Also be reminded that tents are not permitted on the sidewalks but may be used in parklets or on private property. Umbrellas are permitted as long as they do not obstruct the sidewalk.
